**ORDER GRANTING
DEFENDANT-INTERVENOR'S
MOTION TO SHORTEN TIME**

1 The court received the Motion to Shorten Time and the Motion for an Order Pursuant to
2 RCW 29A.68.011 shortly before noon on August 28, 2013, and the court recognizes that the
3 other parties in this matter have had very little time to respond. However, the court also recog-
4 nizes that time is of the essence for a decision on the underlying motion, due to King County's

9 serve their responses no later than 4:30 p.m. on Thursday, August 29. Any materials in strict

12 with proposed orders in Word format at the time the materials are filed and served.

13 3. Defendant-Intervenor's "Motion for an Order Pursuant to RCW 29A.68.011
14 Directing the City Clerk to Determine the Sufficiency of Additional Signatures That Have Been
15 Provided to Her" will be considered on September 3, 2013 without oral argument.
